

## Raising Standards in PE

### 2 Hours Weekly Curriculum PE

Guaranteed for a minimum of 2 school terms, our SS Co will design the lessons around the Festival Programme each half term. Curriculum lesson plans will be created and provided for each lesson.

### Staff CPD / Upskilling

As part of the 2 Hour offer, we will work with your TA / LSA staff to develop their skills, knowledge and experience of PE planning and delivery. This will include team teaching and shadow learning.

### School Inset Training

Your school will be provided with one PE inset training event at your school or at MCSC, focusing on a specific area of PE / Sport development highlighted by your school.

### Governor Workshop

An evening session identifying the expectations and responsibilities set out by central government for the Sport Premium funding within your school.

### Staff Training

A minimum of 3 training courses per year (2 school staff per event), covering all age groups and sport specific courses. Delivered by the Youth Sport Trust.

## How we can help you provide the best possible PE provision

### Joint Lesson Observations

Our SS Co /partnership manager will work with your school's PE coordinator or head teacher and observe 1 in house PE lesson per term, to ensure quality, assess impact and highlight training needs.

### PE & School Sport Updates & Advice

The partnership manager will continue to work with the Youth Sport Trust and highlight any changes that are made nationally to the PE & School Sport priorities and initiatives and update our partner school accordingly.

### Equipment Resource Library

The school and sports centre have a large equipment resource and our goal is to make this equipment available to our partner schools, free of charge, in a library style system.

### Continuation of SS Co Role

The role of SS Co has been retained by the sports centre over the past 3 years, since he changes to the sports premium funding. This role has been highlighted as essential to our package offer, ensuring that we can offer high quality curriculum designed provision. The SS Co is also responsible for coordinating and delivering the full competition calendar, supporting our after school offer and staff training.

### **Centralised Primary Competition Calendar**

The primary competition calendar will ensure that every child in your school is able to participate in competitive and fun inter school competitions. The package will include over 20 festivals aimed at every year group (at least 3 events per year group) & will include ten Level 2 district qualifying events.

All events will be held on a Wednesday, from 1pm - 3pm.

### **Partnership Shield**

A new initiative for 2017/18. We will be introducing a partnership shield that will run in a league format, before a winner is decided at the end of the school year. Points will be awarded for attendance, fair play and competition success.

Information will be displayed on the new partnership webpage, so that pupils (and teachers / heads teacher!!!) can keep an eye on their schools progress.

### **Competition Development for Pupils & Staff**

As part of our 2 hour PE offer, we will pay additional focus on competition rules, skills and tactics, prior to upcoming events within the competition calendar.

### **Intra School Competition**

Our partnership manager will work with the young ambassadors at your school to organise and run 3 intra school competitions per years (1 per term). These events will be supported by the sports leaders at Malton School.

This initiative can be utilised to develop numeracy and literacy projects to support the event, such as competition scoring, creating rules and team sheets and event reports.

### **Staff Competitions**

As part of the partnership shield, your school will be invited to participate in a termly sporting event. This will support staff morale and wellbeing. Points for participation, fair play and success will all be added to your school's shield points total. Events will include Netball, Rounders and Dodgeball (mixed gender) - This is your opportunity for your staff to act as sporting role models to your students.

### **Sports Day Support**

Young Leaders from Malton School can be provided to support your sports day provision. This will be subject to the availability of the students.

### KS2 Leadership Programme

Our leadership (Ambassador) programme has proven very successful over the past 4 years, and we are looking to enhance the provision this year. We will continue to deliver 3 ambassador training events (1 per term) along with our annual rewards trip.

This training will upskill your selected leaders to be able to organise, manage and deliver sports provision to their peer groups during break times at school.

This year we will also be working more in depth with the ambassadors, supporting them to organise and run 3 intra school sporting events during the 17/18 calendar year. Our own sports leaders from Malton School will be on hand to support these events, and provide your ambassadors with support and guidance.

### 30 Minutes Per Day Inset Training

The partnership manager or SSCo will come in to school to discuss the new 30 minutes per day requirement that the government have introduced to all school in all year groups.

As part of this initiative, we will also provide regular updates on the development of and potential changes to the initiative, along with providing resources and support.

### Change 4 Life Training & Resources

Working with the SGO, we will support all partner primary schools in accessing Change 4 Life training and equipment.

### Inter School Sports Day

After a successful and really enjoyable pilot event in 2016, we will deliver a full school sports day at Malton School. The day will be split into KS1 (fun) and KS2 (competitive) events, with the winning school in the KS2 event taking home the Ryedale Shield.

### Inactive Pupil Engagement

Within our Competition Calendar there will be opportunities to support children who do not regularly participate in sporting activity, be it due to health or opportunity barriers. We will support your school in engaging with these pupils through a number of fun festivals.

### Mile a Day – Set Up and Promotional Assembly

The partnership manager will set up a mile course within your school grounds and will visit the school to discuss the initiative and the benefits of participating, as part of a special assembly and taster event. Rewards will be provided at certain target points to support continued engagement. This is a great project for your ambassadors to support.

## Impact & Achievement

## How we can help you achieve & demonstrate positive impact

### Affiliation to the Malton Sports Partnership

As a member your school will become affiliated to our partnership and will be provided with our partnership logo to display on your school's website.

You will be provide access to our partnership web page, which will display up to date information relating to all aspects of the package, festivals dates and times, the Partnership shield league table, session plans and updates to changes in government initiatives, funding and criteria.

We will also create a social media account for the partnership, to encourage school staff and parents to share relevant information, experiences and enjoyment.

### Sports Premium Advice & Guidance

We will keep you up to date with any new changes to the sports premium funding and provide advice and guidance on the funding expectations.

### Youth Sport Trust Membership

As part of our package, your school will automatically be signed up to the Youth Sport Trust Level 2 package. The YST work hand in hand with the government and provide the best programme of training and support for primary schools.

As part of your YST membership, you will be able to access all of their online content and undertake their PE & School Sport self-assessment initiative

### Youth Sport Trust PE & School Sport Self-Assessment

The partnership manager will support your school in undertaking the annual self-assessment of PE & School sport. This certification is highly regarded by Ofsted.

### Annual Action Planning

You will be provided with a national recognised action planning tool which will help form your annual and long term goals and targets. Support will be provided with this planning, where required. This action plan will help identify your areas of development and will assist with impact assessment.

### Impact Assessment

The single biggest change to the sports premium funding criteria, schools will now be asked to provide reports and updates on the impact of their PE & school sport provision, how it is achieving national goals and targets and how you plan on investing the funding for greater impact moving forward. The partnership manager will support you with this assessment process.

### **After School Sports Clubs**

We can deliver a variety of after school sports clubs at your site. We provide all equipment and level 2 qualified sports coaches who are employed full time by Malton School, ensuring they have achieved all expected minimum standards (relevant coaching qualifications, first aid and safeguarding trained, DBS cleared).

### **Delivery of PE Provision**

In addition to the 2 hour offer within this package, we can come out to your setting and deliver curriculum PE provision to all other students within your school, whilst helping upskill your staff.

### **Additional Requirements**

We can cater for a variety of PE & School Sport needs that may not be included in this main package. For example, in previous years we have undertaken the writing of sport funding applications, set up orienteering courses, organised first aid training, undertaken inspections of school equipment and managed subsequent procurement processes, and written risk assessments. ### **Forest School Provision**

This is a new addition to our package offer and moves away from the traditional sporting element. Forest School is a provision of learning opportunities based in a natural woodland setting, over a sustained long term period. Forest School offers unique opportunities for students to develop at their own pace and as an all-round person, very much looking at the holistic development of each individual.

The activities involved will offer the opportunity for creativity, self-expression, risk taking, team work and individual working, and to learn and develop new skills, whilst building confidence, self-esteem and self-worth, all in a natural environment. Forest school practice covers literacy numeracy, DT, art & much more, as well as individual growth

A forest School provision is currently in development at Malton School and will open from September 2017. Our lead practitioner is Level 3 qualified and over the next year we will be training 2 support staff to Level 2.

This provision is available to groups of 6 children who will participate in a weekly 2 hour session, over a sustained period of 30 weeks – no matter what the weather!

Transportation to and from the venue can also be provided at a heavily subsidised cost.
